Avril, Didion, Mary, 1850 The small expense of the apparatus will enable the process of preserving timber to be applied in cases where it has not hitherto been available. It will be economy for all proprietors of land of any extent, to preserve the timber used on their estates for fencing, farm-buildings, gate-posts, c.; an advantage that has hitherto been denied them, as the impregnation of the timber (however effective the material may be) is entirely useless applied under great pressure, which requires expensive cylinders and steam-apparatus, involving an expenditure of from 500 to 1,000. As stated before, the tubular structure of trees has of course long been known, and the idea of impregnating the tree by means of the sap-tubes has long engaged the attention of scientific men; but it has fallen to the lot of Dr. Boucherie, with a perseverance rarely excelled, to bring about its practical application, and...



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
