More importantly, it contains 10 case studies of restructuring through mergers and acquisitions that have taken place in India during the last decade. The work, based on extensive statistical exercises, brings out the major issues that actually crop up in a restructuring exercise. The book, it is hoped, will enhance the understanding of the subject which has assumed added significance in the wake of liberalisation and openness wave sweeping across the world.
